Our vision is to cultivate a central line of support equipped with emotional and tangible resources that illuminates the mental health impact of job displacement.

MAJOR MILESTONES

January

Partnered with Ametros to launch our services to their 18,000 members, marking a significant step in expanding our reach and supporting displaced workers
nationwide.

March

- •March 21, 2023 Workers' Compensation Research Institute (WCRI) Conference, Phoenix, AZ: Hosted our first "Cocktails and Connections: Networking For A Cause" event, introducing Kind Souls Foundation to key stakeholders in the workers' compensation space.
- •First Caller: Received our first call, a pivotal moment that brought our mission to life and affirmed the importance of our services.
